

Foreign Involvement in the Middle East and North Africa

Overview

In this lesson, students will use a graphic organizer to explore and compare foreign involvement in various countries in the Middle East and North Africa and evaluate how it has shaped and is shaping countries in the region today.

One class

Middle East and North Africa (World101)

Graphic organizer (attached)

Instructional Plan

- 1. Have students explore the Middle East and North Africa in World101.
- 2. Assign or have students choose a country. Countries with significant histories of foreign involvement include: Algeria, Egypt, Israel, Iran, Iraq, Jordan, Kuwait, Lebanon, Libya, Saudi Arabia, Syria, and Yemen.
- 3. Have students fill out the attached graphic organizer.
- 4. Have students report out and discuss patterns that emerge.
